Eugenio Ficaibi



Eugenio Ficaibi (S. Bonifacio 1858 - Firenze 1923), a professor at Pisa University where he carried out histological research on vertebrate integument, was then called to fill the chair of Zoology and Comparative Anatomy in Messina. On the death, in 1900, of Giovanni Canestrini, he transferred to Padua as Professor of Zoology and Comparative Anatomy and Physiology. At the same time he became director of the "Gabinetto" of Zoology and Comparative Anatomy. In 1904, he returned to Pisa University and remained there until his death. He was the author of a textbook on General Zoology (1895-98).
