Corrado Parona



Corrado Parona (Corteleona of Pavia, 1878 - Genova 1922). Parona graduated in Medicine in Pavia and moved to the University of Genova in 1883 on a chair of Zoology. In this University, he was Director of the Institute of Zoology and founded, together with Giacomo Cattaneo, the "Bollettino dei Musei di Zoologia e Anatomia Comparata dell'Università di Genova". His research interest was varied, from biology of Collembola and Thysanura to the problems of fishing in particular corals and tuna. His principal contribution was, however, in helmintholgy through the publication (1894, 1911-1912) of volumes on "Elmintologia Italiana".
